Daylight Basement

Definition

A daylight basement is normally built on a sloping site were the foundation walls are partially exposed to allow for the installation of windows and a door. This type of basement allows for the door to open into the yard, because the basement is at ground level. The exposed portion of the basement wall typically includes a stucco and paint finish on the exterior of standard concrete or masonry wall construction.
